If your travel plan needs reviewing or updating then call our School Travel Planning team. We can also help with data entry and analysis. STPs are moving over to a new online electronic system and it supports schools with working towards STARS.

## The Parkwise Promise

Schools that take the "Parkwise Promise" encourage parents and carers to park responsibly when they drive their children to school. We supply free campaign materials such as car stickers and leaflets.

## Scooter training

We offer free scooter training to children from Reception to Year 4. The courses are fun, focus on safety and hands-on. Just what they need to be.



## Walking to school

Become a WoW school by encouraging pupils to 'walk once a week' or 'walk on Wednesdays' each week of the month and they are then rewarded with a collectable themed badge.

Walk to school week and month is a regular event in May and October which holds great interest for pupils and parents and gives teachers a focal point. You can make a big deal of it by holding a sponsored walk, promote 'be bright be seen' and link it with other events.

## Postcode mapping

Using your travel survey data, we can provide a visual and accurate picture of your school's current travel patterns. It shows pupils who live within a 5, 10, 15 minute walking or cycling distance from the school, and what footpaths, cyclepaths, bus routes etc are available too. We can also do this for staff.

## Engineering advice

Through reviewing your travel plan you may find out that you may need some advice about travel, transport and access issues either on or off the school site. Our transport engineers provide advice about solutions, how it could be managed or possible funding for implementation.

## Streets Ahead

Pedestrian training  
Road safety

Streets Ahead is a pedestrian training scheme for Year 2 children delivered in schools by Road Safety. The scheme teaches skills for dealing with road safety situations including:

- crossing roads
- playing safely
- using special crossing places
- choosing the safest route



## Junior Road Safety Officers

JRSO's are Y5 and 6 pupils who act as road safety champions. JRSOs receive packs and pupils are empowered to take responsibility for their own safety as well as that of their peers through fun learning activities.

## Bike maintenance

Have one of our team of Bike Doctors run a series of free bike repair and servicing to keep pupils, staff and parents cycling safely.

Alternatively run a bike maintenance session to help pupils, parents or staff to repair their own bikes, provide them with practical skills to ensure safe cycling.
